23 April 2019 - China Everbright Limited's ("Everbright", stock code: 165.HK) volunteer team visited Sham Shui Po (South) Integrated Family Service Centre of International Social Service Hong Kong Branch, jointly organized the "Easter Egg Creation Activity" with a local NGO, "Yum Cha Together", to show love and care to children from underprivileged families in Sham Shui Po district. The children felt the joy of Easter through designing the Easter eggs and having Chinese dim sum together. Ms. Joephy Chan, Member of the Sham Shui Po District Council, was invited to the event, where she visited and cared for the underprivileged group within the community in

person.



The children who participated in the event are mainly from single-parent families, new immigrant families or low-income bracket in Sham Shui Po district. They usually have very limited chance to join extracurricular activities. The Easter egg creation activity with the volunteers helped to build the children's confidence, improve their communication skills, and experience a festive spirit. Every Easter egg created every single child were beautiful and unique, and the volunteers complimented their creativity and imagination. All participants enjoyed Chinese dim sum after the event, and spent a pleasant afternoon together.
